

Tutorial for Socks ("Basic Favourites – 12 inch male fashion dolls") www.meretesyr.se

Choose a stretchy fabric that does not fray, for example cotton jersey.

I recommend using a (fabric) glue pen instead of pins when sewing this very tiny garment.

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1. You need this pattern piece.



2. Fold a small piece of fabric (bigger than the pattern piece), right side in. Make sure the thread direction is correct. Attach the outer edges (except the one at the top) with a glue pen. Cut a straight edge at the top.
(This is a special glue pen for sewing that does not hurt the sewing machine. The glue dries quickly and becomes almost invisible, and it washes away.)
You can use pins instead of a glue pen, but it is easier to use the glue pen.



3. Trace the pattern on the fabric.



4. Sew ON TOP OF the marking with an elastic seam, for example a reinforced straight stitch. Attach securely at the ends of the seam.



5. Cut away the seam allowance so that there is one millimeter left. (The top of the sock is supposed to be a raw edge.)



6. Turn the sock, you can use a pin carefully to help. Make one more sock just like this one.

7. Finished!
