

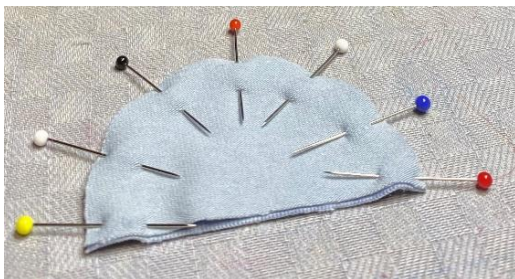
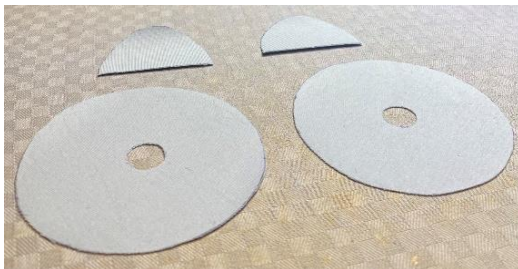
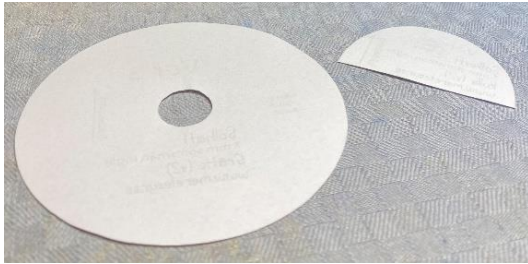
## Tutorial for Sun Hat (53 "Summer – 11.5 inch Fashion Dolls") [www.meretesyr.se](http://www.meretesyr.se)

Choose a stretchy fabric that does not fray, for example cotton jersey.

### Licence

You are **not allowed to copy the pattern** and share with others. You are allowed to sell the finished products that you sew yourself.

1. You need these pattern pieces.
2. When you have cut the fabric, the pieces should look like this.
3. Place the two smaller pieces on top of each other, right sides together. Attach with fabric glue pen or with pins. (This is a special glue pen for sewing that does not hurt the sewing machine. The glue dries quickly and becomes almost invisible, and it washes away.)
4. Sew with a stretchy stitch, for example a reinforced straight stitch or a small zigzag.



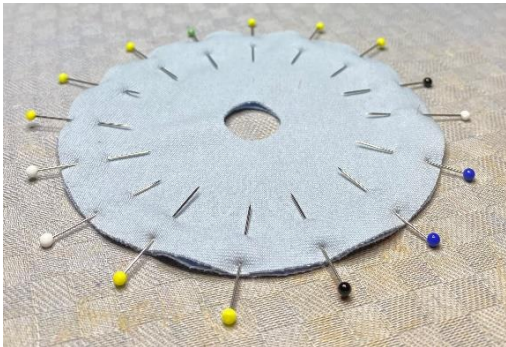
5. Cut away some of the seam allowance so that only a couple of millimeters remain.



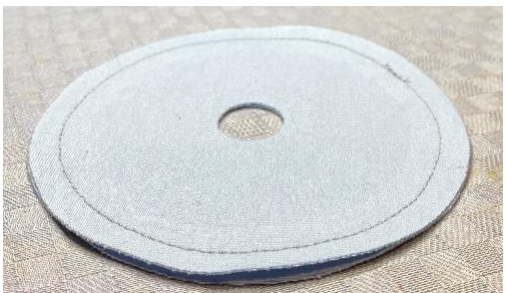
6. Pry the seam allowances apart and attach them with the glue pen.



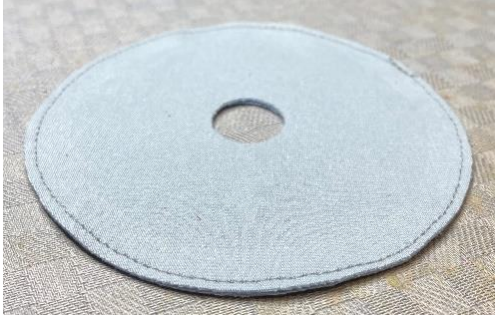
7. Turn the crown right side out and place pins in the mid part of the two pieces.



8. Place the two pieces for the brim right sides together and attach with pins or fabric glue pen.



9. Sew with a straight stitch.



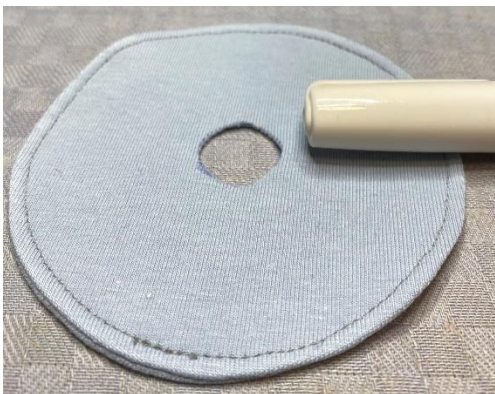
10. Cut away some of the seam allowance so that only a couple of millimeters remain.



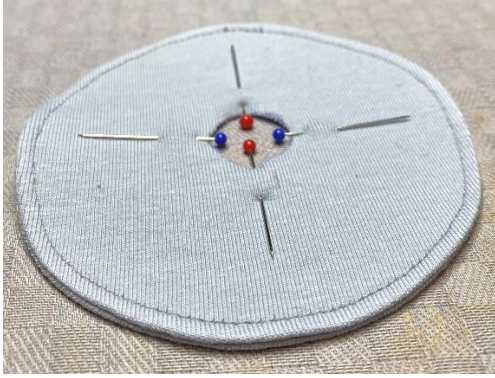
11. Turn the brim right sides out and press.



12. Sew with a straight stitch close to the edge.



13. Attach the two layers with glue pen at the non-sewn edges.



14. Place 4 pins evenly spaced out.



15. Place the brim and the crown, right sides together and edge-to-edge. Attach using the pins.



16. This is what it should look like now.



17. Replace the pins with fabric glue pen (remove the needles, they are in the way when sewing).



18. Sew.

It is very tricky to sew this part on a machine. Here I used my smallest presser foot (the one I use for sewing zippers) and sewed with a reinforced straight stitch.

**Option:** Sew by hand!



19. This is what it should look like now.



20. Cut away some of the seam allowance so that only a couple of millimeters remain.



21. Finished!
